Dr. Jagannath Patil [JP] serves as Adviser at National Assessment and Accreditation Council of India (NAAC). He is the immediate Past President of Asia Pacific Quality Network [APQN]. He was the first Asian expert elected as president of INQAAHE in 2015-2016. He is founder Chairperson of Asia Pacific Quality Register [APQR]. He has coordinated Accreditation for over 1500 Institutions. He was the Convenor of first Global Summit with 16 international partners organised by NAAC and APQN which culminated in historic Bengaluru Statement 2016 on Next- generation Quality assurance in Higher education. He served on many working groups and mission of UNESCO and World Bank, etc.

He played key role in international projects and collaborations including APQN - ENQA - Arab Network (ANQAHE) Consortium project on QA of Cross Border Higher Education, APQN MoUs with European Consortium of Accreditation (ECA), EASPA and Commonwealth of Learning (COL). He led APQN database of consultants project with INQAAHE and ANQAHE for many years.

JP is recipient of *Endeavor Award*, 2007, Australia; Decennial Award, APQN, 2013; Plaque of Honor, ONESQA, Thailand, 2014 and Lifetime Achievement Award by *Dr. BAM University*, India, 2017.
