- The Mexican Senate has passed legislation that would require all Mexican universities to undergo external evaluations or lose their operating licences. The bill, which is awaiting approval in the lower house of the National Congress, would overhaul a 37-year-old governing higher education, and would for the first time make accreditation mandatory for all college-level programmes.

The bill is a response to growing concerns over the proliferation of 'junk universities,' which critics say make up a majority of the more than 1,800 private universities. The bill's sponsors cited 'the proliferation of institutions that do not comply with the standards of the students or society.'
