

# **Quarterly Communiqué to the General Assembly**

Quarter 4, 2017

With the fourth quarter communique - October-December 2017 – we are happy to share the following outstanding activities and achievements by INQAAHE. Overall, the year has been a successful one in terms of accomplishment of the set goals in the INQAAHE Strategic Plan 2013-2017 and a move to the new Strategic Plan 2018-2022 which is planned to take INQAAHE to the new heights.

# **ORGANISATIONAL ASPECTS**

To enhance the operations of the INQAAHE Board, a number of major activities have been undertaken:

- INQAAHE Funding Scheme: The Call for Proposals for 2017 was developed based on the approved budget 2017. For 2017, USD 30,000.00 was allocated to fund the IFS Window 2 (Capacity Building) and USD5,000.00 for IFS Window 3 (Research and Innovation) (see the approved IFS Operational Manual 2017). The Call for Proposals for 2017 was launched in mid-July 2017. A Webinar on Grant Writing was conducted towards the end of July to support our members in writing successful proposals for grants. By the set deadline seven Capacity Building and ten Research proposals were received. On 18 December, by the Board decision, external reviewers were approved to evaluate the proposals. The results will be announced at the end of January 2018.
- Global Survey on EQA and IQA: INQAAHE is conducting a global survey on EQA and IQA in all regions of the world. The INQAAHE Global Survey is being conducted in cooperation with UNESCO and regional networks ENQA, APQN, CEENQA, CANQATE, AfriQAN, and EUA. Regional university associations are being contacted to support data collection from the higher education institutions. The survey instruments, which are intended for both QA agencies and HEIs, are being revised by regional networks to ensure relevance to the regional peculiarities and needs. The survey has been completed in the Arab Region and in Latin America and the Caribbean. The surveys for all other regions are still in progress. The results of the study will be published by INQAAHE in a 2018 Global Scoping Study Report and will feed into the 2018 UNESCO Global Conference on Quality Assurance in Paris. This is a regular exercise INQAAHE undertakes every three years to better understand the trends in QA and benefit the systems worldwide.
- Revision of Constitution: The Constitution Revision Working Group, with Pauline Tang (Vice President of INQAAHE Board) as Chair and Members: Carol Bobby, Anthony McClaran and Erika Soboleva finalised the new Constitution draft. The draft was circulated among the GA for their feedback. The Committee is thankful to all members for their invaluable feedback. The new constitution will be sent for an external audit prior to its adoption. - INQAAHE New Strategic Plan 2018-2022: a Working Group under the lead of the President was established to develop the INQAAHE new Strategic Plan 2018-2022. An extensive study of the impact of INQAAHE on its members throughout the years, the effectiveness and level of completion of the current Strategic Plan 2013-2017 and the extensive data accumulated by the Secretariat have been analysed to feed into the background information for the development of the new Strategic Plan. The draft new Strategic Plan was circulated among the GA members for their feedback, discussed widely at the Board level and was approved on 18 December 2017 for its full implementation in January 2018. - QAP Programme: INQAAHE is offering a Quality Assurance Programme through two HEIs University of Melbourne (language of instruction is English) and Open University of Catalunya (language of instruction is Spanish). The QAP programme is currently undergoing a major revision to ensure relevance of the courses offered. The QAP Programme working group is led by Anthony McClaran, INQAAHE Board member. The group includes Carol Bobby and Erika Soboleva – who are both INQAAHE Board members. It also includes QAP providers.
  - Call for QAP Scholarships. A new agreement is to be signed with the LH Martin Institute for Higher Education Leadership and Management at the University of Melbourne for the dissemination of the programme. Call for 2017-2018 Scholarships will be announced in January for the course starting in March 2018.
- Revision/development of criteria for INQAAHE membership: the INQAAHE Membership and Member Services Committee is currently revising the criteria for different types of INQAAHE memberships and strategic partners.
- INQAAHE Strategic Partners: INQAAHE has about 21 Strategic Partners, which are international organisations (e.g. UNESCO), regional, subject specific, and special interest networks and other organisations that are involved in quality assurance. INQAAHE will be renewing/signing MoUs with the Strategic Partners to tighten collaborative ties and promote joint projects.
- **Global Quality Assurance Register:** a working group composed of Board members is charged with a study on the potential for, and uses and benefits of establishing a Global Quality Assurance Register.

## **EVENTS**

INQAAHE 11<sup>th</sup> Biennial Forum: A Working Group under the lead of the Chair Eddy Chong, an INQAAHE Board Director, was formed to launch the preparatory activities. The Forum will take place on 2-4 May 2018 and will be proudly hosted by the Mauritius Tertiary Education Commission (TEC). The theme for the 2018 Forum is *Quality is in the Eye of the Beholder: Relevance, Credibility and International Visibility.* The preliminary agenda has been finalised and the launch of the Forum website with the call for participation will be announced in December 2017.



- The Events Committee in collaboration with CINDA, is currently in the process of organising a QA event in Latin America. The event is to take place on 8-10 January 2018 and will evolve around QA issues and developments in the region. - UNESCO/INQAAHE/ICDE/CoL/WB/CHEA/CIQG/DAAD Conference 2018:
  - As a precursor to the UNESCO Global Conference in 2018, INQAAHE is currently coorganising a global survey in different parts of the world.

## **GGP ALIGNMENT**

- Aligned Agencies:
  - <u>National Accreditation Commission (CNA)</u>, Chile is aligned with INQAAHE GGP for the period of 7 November 2017 7 November 2022, after a successful external review.
- Development of the GGP Alignment Procedures: The Recognition Committee is currently developing procedures for GGP alignment. Several options for GGP alignment procedures are offered to lessen the burden of agencies that are eager to undergo a GGP alignment, as well as to ensure that members can avail themselves of the opportunity to be GGP aligned, thus attesting and reaffirming the credibility of their provisions. The new procedures manual will be released officially in spring 2018.

  - Research and Innovation. All the grant holders for the INQAAHE 2016 Funding Scheme have submitted their final reports and have received the relevant funding.



- Capacity Building.
  - CUE (KENYA): Due to the political situation in the country, CUE has not been able to fulfill the deadlines set in the agreement.
  - QAA (UK): Agreement still pending.
  - AQU Catalunya: Deliverables and deadlines are fulfilled. It is scheduled to finish in December.
