# **Quarter 1, 2018**

With the first quarterly communique – January to March 2018 – we are happy to share the outstanding activities and achievements by INQAAHE. Overall, the launch of the new year for INQAAHE was marked with the inauguration of the new Strategic Plan (2018-2022), targeting new heights for the organisation and the membership at large, as well as active contribution to regional developments.

#### **ORGANISATIONAL ASPECTS**

#### To enhance the operations of the INQAAHE Board, a number of major activities have been undertaken:

- INQAAHE launched 2018 with the new Strategic Plan (2018-2022), which is further detailed in the Activity Plan for 2018. Please click here for the new Strategic Plan 2018-2022.
- Close to the end of 2017 and the beginning of 2018, a new Working Group was established to explore the feasibility of new approaches to the INQAAHE organisational structure and operations. The WG is led by Carol Bobby and involves the following Board members: Anthony McClaran and Franz Gertze.
- At the beginning of February 2018, the Secretariat announced the call for nominations for the INQAAHE President and the INQAAHE Board. The voting for both the President and the Board is now close, which ended on 5<sup>th</sup> of April 2018, and, the results will be announced on the 20<sup>th</sup> of April.

## **INQAAHE FUNDING SCHEME**

During the first quarter of the year, results of Calls 2017-2018 were announced. The Call for Proposals 2017-2018 was developed based on the approved budget 2017: USD 30,000.00 was allocated to fund the IFS Window 2 (Capacity Building) and USD 5,000.00 for IFS Window 3 (Research and Innovation) (see the approved IFS Operational Manual 2017).

#### **GLOBAL SURVEY ON EQA AND IQA**

INQAAHE is conducting a global survey on EQA and IQA in all regions of the world. The results obtained were encouraging, nonetheless, to ensure more responses the INQAAHE announced a second round of survey. The deadline for the second round is end of March. The study will be first presented at the INQAAHE Forum in Mauritius. Close to the end of 2018 the INQAAHE Global Study will be published. The regions that still need further attention in terms of data collection are the Northern America and the Asia Pacific.

#### **REVISION OF CONSTITUTION**

The new constitution draft has undergone external audit by the following experts:



- Pr. Heinz-Ulrich Schmidt, Mindirig. a.D./former Director General of Higher Education and Research, Foundation for International Business Administration Accreditation (FIBAA). Expert with background in quality assurance and law.
- Pra. Susanna Oromí Vall-llovera, Professor of Procedural Law, University of Girona. Expert in legal documentation drafting.

After the external review process, the Constitution Revision Working Group, with Pauline Tang (Vice President of INQAAHE Board) as Chair and Members: Carol Bobby, Anthony McClaran and Erika Soboleva, distributed the updated version of the Constitution Revision draft to the INQAAHE Board for final comments and approval. The review of the document is now completed and will be presented to the General Assembly for open discussion and adoption at the INQAAHE 11<sup>th</sup> Biennial Forum in Mauritius

#### **QAP PROGRAMME**

INQAAHE is offering a Quality Assurance Programme through two HEIs — University of Melbourne (language of instruction is English) and Open University of Catalunya (language of instruction is Spanish). The QAP programme is currently undergoing a major revision to ensure relevance of the courses offered. The QAP Programme working group is led by Anthony McClaran, INQAAHE Board member. The group includes Carol Bobby and Erika Soboleva — who are both INQAAHE Board members. It also includes QAP providers.

Call for QAP Scholarships. A new agreement is to be signed with the LH Martin Institute for Higher Education Leadership and Management at the University of Melbourne for the dissemination of the programme. Call for 2017-2018 Scholarships will be announced in January for the course starting in March 2018.

#### REVISION/DEVELOPMENT OF CRITERIA FOR INQAAHE MEMBERSHIP

The INQAAHE Membership and Member Services Committee is currently revising the criteria for different types of INQAAHE memberships and strategic partners.

#### **GLOBAL QUALITY ASSURANCE REGISTER**

A working group composed of Board members is charged with a study on the potential for, and uses and benefits of establishing a Global Quality Assurance Register.



#### **EVENTS**

### INQAAHE 11TH BIENNIAL FORUM

The Forum will take place from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> of May, 2018, to be proudly hosted by the Mauritius Tertiary Education Commission (TEC). The theme for the 2018 Forum is *Quality is in the Eye of the Beholder: Relevance, Credibility and International Visibility.* Pre-Forum workshops covering the sub-themes have been planned to be covered by international experts from Tertiary Education Quality and Standards Agency (TEQSA) of Australia, Higher Education Evaluation & Accreditation Council (HEEACT) of Taiwan, Seychelles Qualifications Authority, and Tertiary Education Commission of Mauritius. The keynote addresses will be delivered by two distinguished speakers, Professor Bjørn Stensaker of the University of Oslo, and Professor Goolam Mohamedbhai, the former Vice-Chancellor of the University of Mauritius. Professor Stensaker will be sharing his thoughts on 'Quality and the Battle for Legitimacy: Discourses, Dependencies and Disputes', whilst Professor Goolam will be speaking on 'The Changing Landscape of Higher Education in Emerging Economies: Challenges for Quality Assurance'.

INQAAHE is funding 7 applications from its members from least developed countries to attend Forum 2018, up to USD 2,500 per application).

# INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON DIVERSITY, QUALITY AND IMPROVEMENT - SANTIAGO, CHILE, 8-10TH OF JANUARY, 2018

The INQAAHE Events Committee in cooperation with CINDA (Centro Interuniversitario de Desarrollo), RIACES (La Red Iberoamericana para el Aseguramiento de la Calidad en la Educación Superior), Ministry of Education of Chile, and IESALC (the UNESCO regional office in Latin America and the Caribbean) organized an international conference on quality assurance in tertiary education in Santiago, Chile, 8<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> of January, 2018.

The focus of the event was on the development of higher education for the 21<sup>st</sup> century - a time of reforms and structural change. Around the world, including Latin-American and the Caribbean region, governments and institutions advocate changes in higher education systems, to provide effective, inclusive, quality higher education
