Deloitte reported that "soft skill-intensive" occupations will account for **two-thirds** of all jobs by 2030."

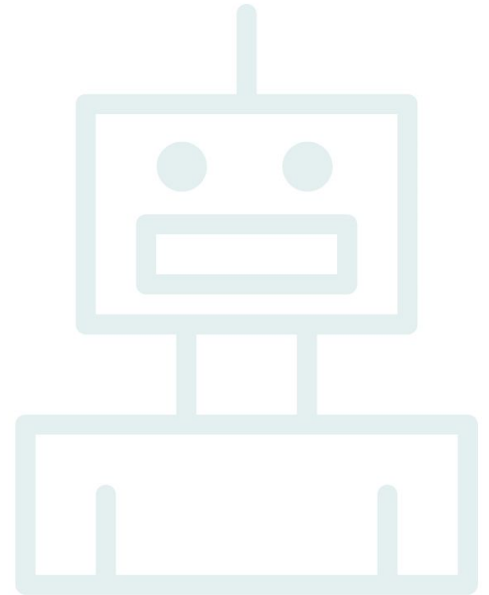




Game Changer: Artificial Intelligence

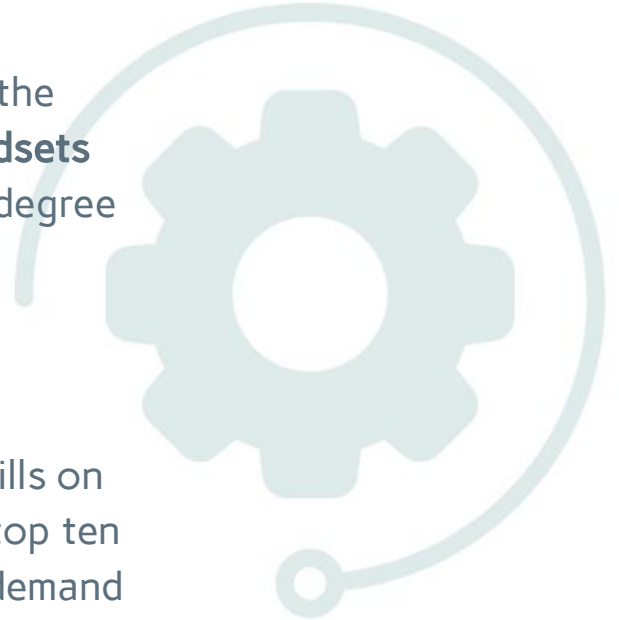
Emerging Theme: Skills-Based Hiring

2023 Skills-First Report, LinkedIn

LinkedIn's 2023 Skills-First Report is centered on reimagining the labor force and breaking down barriers - done by **shifting mindsets** so that we **hire based on skills and learning** and not solely on degree or job title.

The Job Skills of 2023, Coursera

This report presents the fastest-growing digital and human skills on Coursera entering 2023. An interesting find is that while the top ten digital skills vary significantly from 2022, the human skills in demand remain steadier - suggesting an "evergreen" demand for skills like change management and communication.
