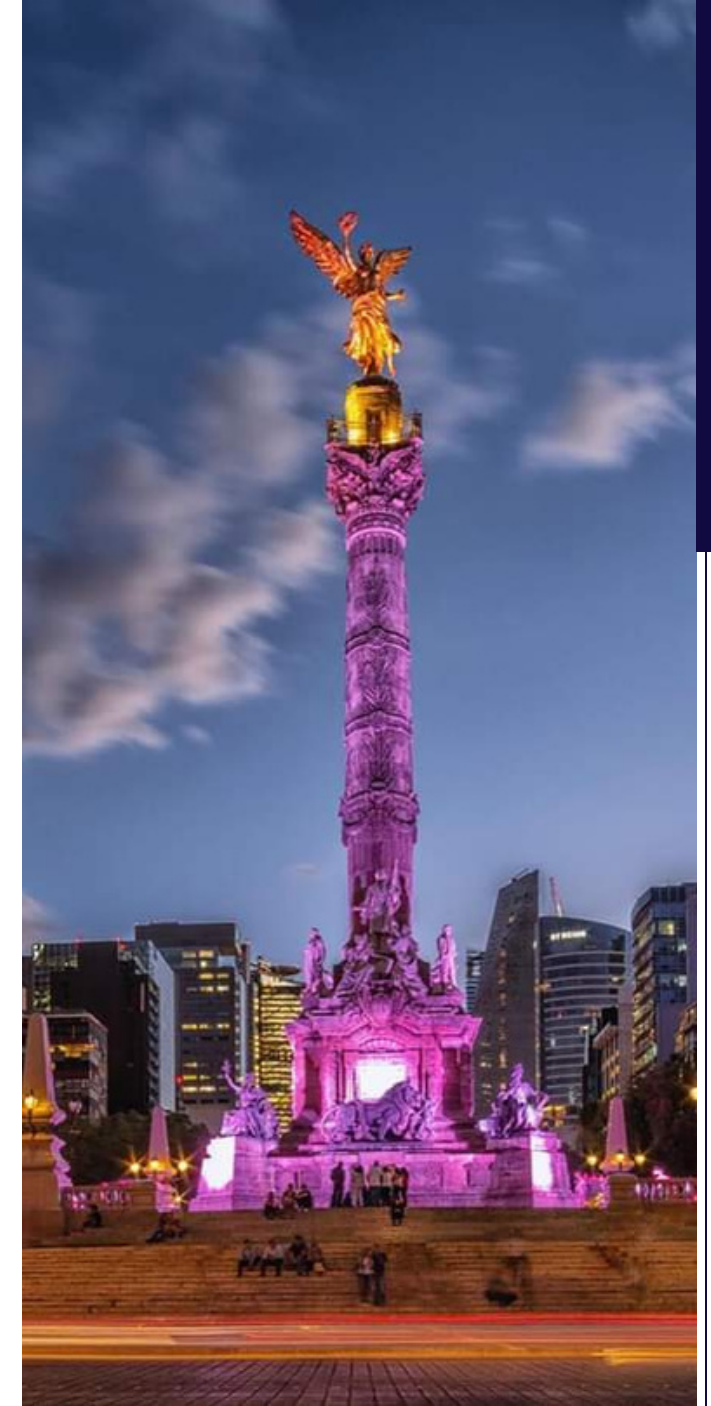

- As capital of the country it concentrates hundreds of Universities.

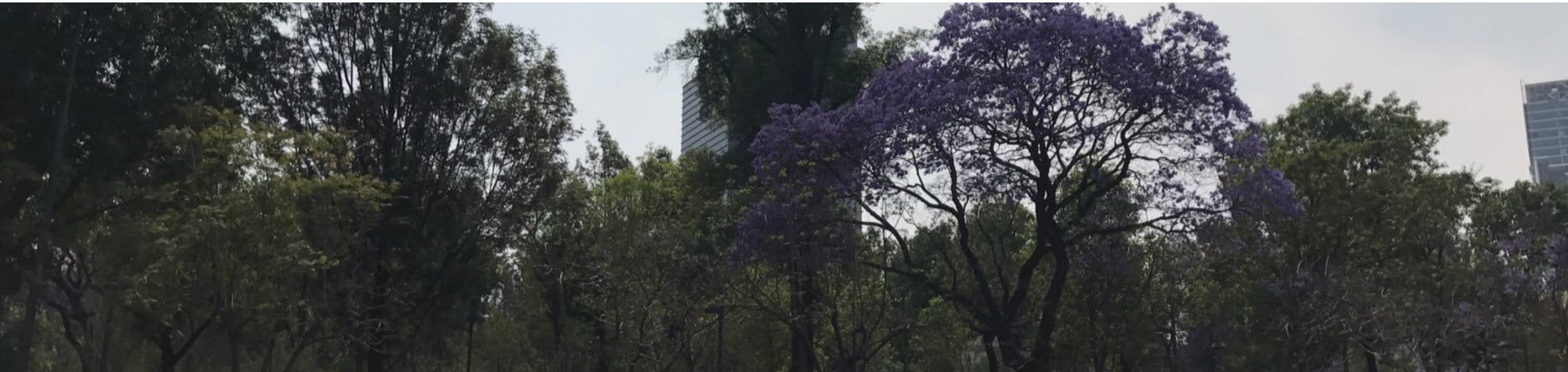

## PALACIO DE MINERIA

It is one of the masterpieces of Neoclassical architecture in the Americas. It was designed and built between 1797 and 1813 by Manuel Tolsá to house the Royal Seminar of Mines. Later, it housed institutions such as the National University, the School of Engineering, College of Mining, and the Physics Institute of the National Autonomous University of Mexico (UNAM). Today it is a museum that belongs to the Faculty of Engineering of UNAM.

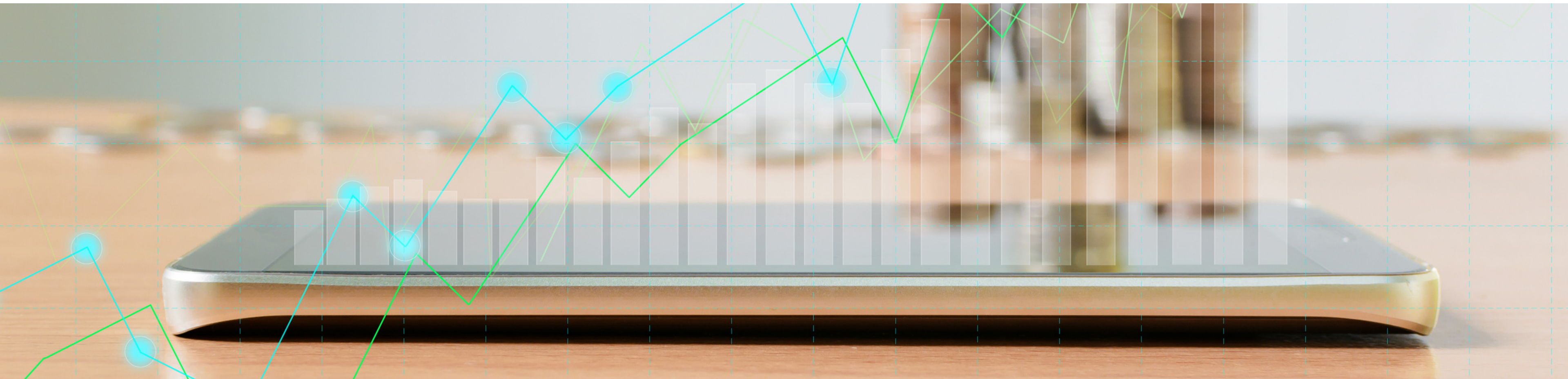




# FEES
