

Quarterly Communiqué to the General Assembly

Quarter 3, 2017

The period of July-September 2017 was marked with hard work from the INQAAHE Board, Secretariat and invaluable contribution of our members to successfully implement planned activities and move our strategies forward. The activities outlined below were implemented within the third quarter of this year.

ORGANISATIONAL ASPECTS

To enhance the operations of the INQAAHE Board, a number of major activities have been undertaken:

- **Finances:** A new approach to the diversification of INQAAHE funding model is being developed. This will allow for additional sources of revenue for INQAAHE, which, in turn, will channel more investment into capacity building and research.
- INQAAHE Funding Scheme: The Call for Proposals for 2017 was developed based on the approved budget 2017. For 2017, USD30,000.00 was allocated to fund the IFS Window 2 (Capacity Building) and USD5,000.00 for IFS Window 3 (Research and Innovation) (see the approved IFS Operational Manual 2017). The Call for Proposals for 2017 was launched in mid-July 2017. A Webinar on Grant Writing was conducted towards the end of July to support our members in writing successful proposals for grants.
- Global Survey on EQA and IQA: INQAAHE is conducting a global survey on EQA and IQA in all regions of the world. The Global Survey is being conducted in cooperation with UNESCO and regional networks ENQA, APQN, CEENQA, CANQATE, AfriQAN, EUA. Regional university associations are being contacted to support data collection from the higher education institutions. The survey instruments, which are intended for both QA agencies and HEIs, are being revised by regional networks to ensure relevance to the regional peculiarities and needs. The project has been completed in the Arab Region and is currently in progress in Latin America. The surveys for all other regions will be launched by the end of September. The results of the study will feed into the 2018 UNESCO Global Conference on Quality Assurance in Paris.
- Revision of Constitution: The Constitution Revision Working Group, with Pauline Tang (Vice President of INQAAHE Board) as Chair and Members: Carol Bobby, Anthony McClaran and Erika Soboleva, have finalised the new Constitution draft. The draft is currently being circulated among the GA for their feedback. The Committee is thankful to all members for the invaluable feedback received thus far and looks forward to receiving more feedback by the set deadline. The new constitution will be sent for an external audit prior to its adoption. - INQAAHE New Strategic Plan 2018-2022: a Working Group under the lead of the President has completed an INQAAHE Impact Study. The results of the Impact Study has been incorporated into the first draft of the new Strategic Plan 2018-2022 to be finalised by the end of November 2017. Currently, the new Strategic Plan is under discussion at the Executive Committee and Board levels after which it will be circulated among the GA members for their feedback, prior to its approval by the Board in December 2017. The report on the INQAAHE Impact Study will be made publicly available in Fall 2017.
- QAP Programme: INQAAHE is offering a Quality Assurance Programme through two HEIs University of Melbourne (language of instruction is English) and Open University of Catalunya (language of instruction is Spanish). The QAP programme is currently undergoing a major revision to ensure relevance of the courses offered. The QAP Programme working group is led by Anthony McClaran, INQAAHE Board member. The group includes Carol Bobby and Erika Soboleva who are both INQAAHE Board members. It also includes QAP providers.

EVENTS

- INQAAHE 11th Biennial Forum: A Working Group under the lead of the Chair Eddy Chong, an INQAAHE Board Director, was formed to launch the preparatory activities. The Forum will take place from 2-4 May 2018 and will be proudly hosted by the Mauritius Tertiary Education Commission (TEC). The theme for the 2018 Forum is Quality is in the Eye of the Beholder: Relevance, Credibility and International Visibility. A Partnership Agreement is currently being signed to set the terms and conditions for both parties INQAAHE as the organiser and TEC as the host.
- The Events Committee in collaboration with CINDA, is currently in the process of organising a QA event in Latin America and the Caribbean. The event is to take place on 8-10 January 2018 and will evolve around QA issues and developments in the regions. For more information, please refer to the announcement/invitation to the conference.
- UNESCO/INQAAHE/ICDE/CoL/WB/CHEA/CIQG/DAAD Conference 2018:
 - As a precursor to the UNESCO Global Conference in 2018, INQAAHE is currently coorganising regional consultation meetings in different parts of the world. Currently, INQAAHE is co-organising an event in Eastern and Western Europe.

GGP ALIGNMENT

- Aligned Agencies:
 - National Accreditation Council (CNA), Colombia is aligned with INQAAHE GGP for the period of 23 August 2017 till 23 August 2022, after a successful external review.
- **GGP Alignment Procedures:** One (1) GGP Alignment case is being processed:
 - <u>National Accreditation Commission (CNA)</u>, Chile. A site visit took place at the end of May.
 The review panel is completing the report.
- Development of the GGP Alignment Procedures: The Recognition Committee is currently developing procedures for GGP alignment. Several options for GGP alignment procedures are offered to lessen the burden of agencies that are eager to undergo a GGP alignment, as well as to ensure that members can avail themselves of the opportunity to be GGP aligned, thus attesting and reaffirming the credibility of their provisions. The new Procedures Manual will be released officially in Fall 2017.

- **INQAAHE Funding Scheme 2016:** All the grant holders for the INQAAHE 2016 Funding Scheme have submitted their mid-term reports. All funded projects are being implemented as per the approved grant proposals.
