## **ACEN Curriculum and Assessment Criteria**

- The nursing curriculum has one set of endof-program student learning outcomes that:
  - are based on contemporary professional nursing standards, guidelines, and/or competencies
  - integrate role-specific nursing competencies applicable to each program option.
- The systematic plan for evaluation describes the process for regular summative nursing program-level assessment of student learning outcome achievement.



### **Learning Objective Example:**

Nursing graduates will be prepared to work and communicate effectively within interprofessional healthcare teams, enhancing the quality of care and improving patient outcomes.


#### **Assessment Methods:**

- Peer and Self-Evaluations




# Curriculum and Outcomes Data Most Frequently Cited Standards/Criteria
