A. Brief profile:

Syeda Asiyah Bukhari serves as the Director of the Quality Enhancement Cell (QEC) at Khyber Medical University (KMU), Peshawar, Pakistan. She has been a pioneer in the field of quality assurance in higher education in Pakistan since 2007. Her contributions have earned her a performance award for successfully achieving targets set by the Quality Assurance Agency of the Higher Education Commission (HEC). During her tenure at KMU, she successfully established a robust quality assurance framework across more than 200 affiliated colleges and institutes, including medical, dental, and allied health sciences institutions. She introduced a performance evaluation system based on quality assurance principles—an initiative implemented for the first time in Pakistan by any university for its affiliated colleges. This achievement earned her recognition and an award from the Quality Assurance Department of the Higher Education Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

Syeda Asiyah Bukhari is the founder of the Pakistan Network of Quality Assurance in Higher Education (PNQAHE), the first quality assurance network of its kind in the subcontinent. She played a pivotal role in fostering collaboration with the International Network of Quality Assurance Agencies in Higher Education (INQAAHE), making PNQAHE a regional partner. Additionally, she launched the *Journal of Quality Assurance in Higher Education (JPNQAHE)* and successfully organized the first three international conferences on quality assurance in Pakistan.

Beyond her work at KMU, she has guided sister universities in the field of quality assurance and has conducted workshops and presentations in countries such as Turkey, Bahrain, Sri Lanka, and Kazakhstan.In the field of biochemistry, Syeda Asiyah Bukhari has conducted groundbreaking research in Pakistan on the role of liquid biopsy in assessing treatment responses in breast cancer patients. Her findings were presented at the European Association for Cancer Research (EACR) conference in Italy and published in the abstract books of the International Society of Liquid Biopsy (ISLB), United States
